## Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM)

### Overview:

The purpose of the Missouri Department of Public Safety's Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) courses are to help Missouri first responders (law enforcement, firefighters, EMT's, dispatchers, as well as clinicians and clergy) to train and certify those that are creating or sustaining a Peer Support Team for their agency.

Attendees of the (3) day CISM/Group Crisis Intervention (GRIN) class will be certified through the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation (ICISF) to be a Peer Support Specialist for their agency.

In the event of a tragic incident many first responders will need to debrief and demobilize from the incident. Be the one that is there at your agency when someone needs to talk and to be listened to after a critical incident occurs. Guide them to the help!

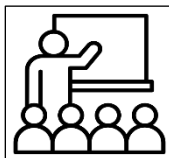
