*In Matthew chapter 1, a Jewish man named Matthew makes a stunning claim: the story we've been longing for isn't fiction. It's real history. God promised a Savior, and in Jesus, He kept His promise. Matthew tells us that Mary's son would be named Immanuel—which means "God with us".*

*If you serve in law enforcement, your Monday-to-Sunday world puts you right on the front lines of a broken world. You step into negative environments, conflict, and situations that can leave you feeling discouraged or defeated. On hard shifts, it's easy to feel like you're just holding back the tide.*

*But Matthew's Gospel points us to a bigger reality: you are living in the story. God didn't stay distant; He came to be with us. When you show up to protect the vulnerable, pursue justice, and bring order to chaos, you aren't just doing a job—you are serving for the Lord and serving the true King who came to restore all things. Stand firm today, knowing that as you serve your community, Immanuel is right there with you.*
