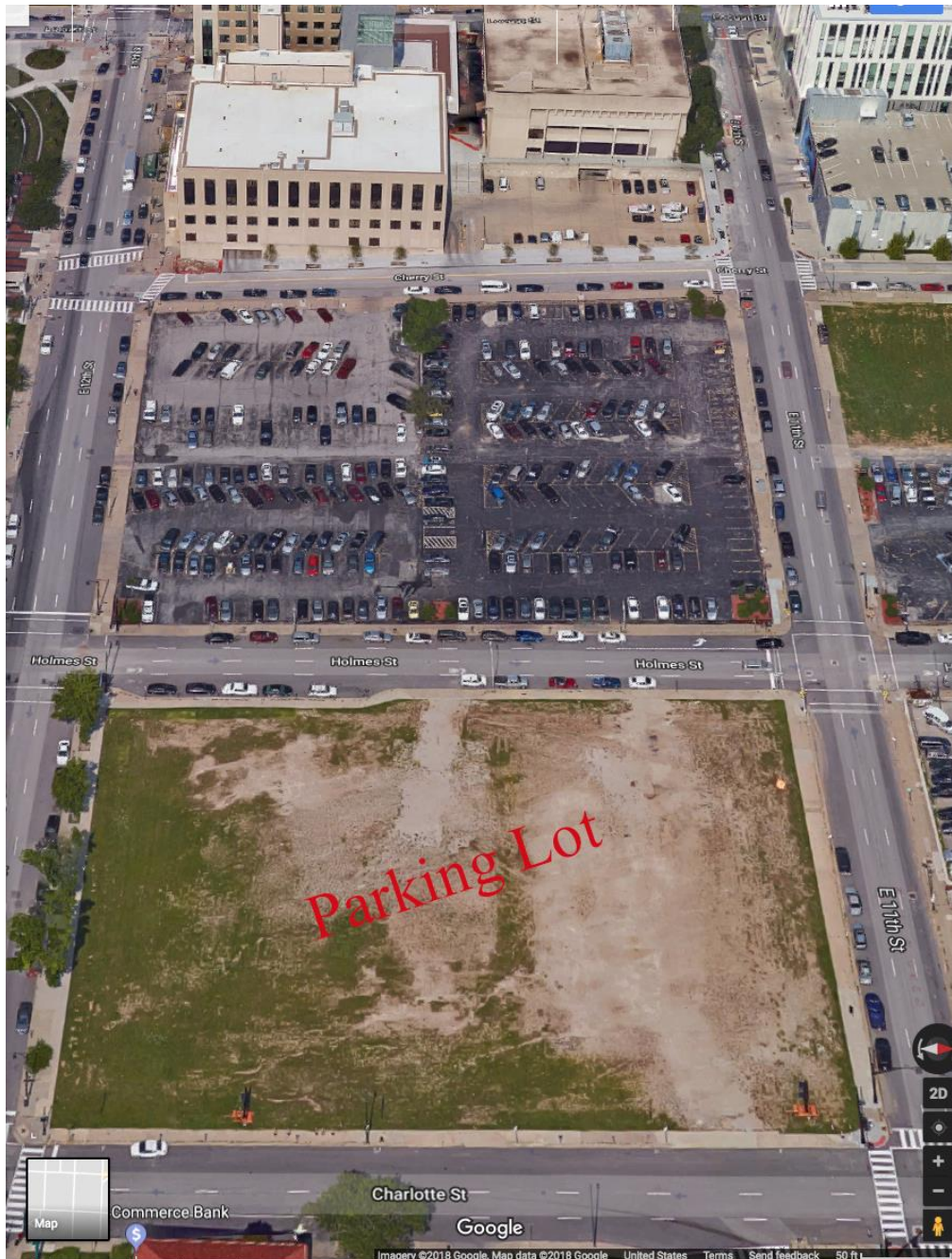

Dress: Officers and sergeants are asked to wear Class A uniforms (long-sleeved shirts with tie) and hat. Commanders are asked to wear Eisenhower Jackets. Black bands are to be worn on badges. If you do not have one, members of the Media Unit will have them available prior to the service.

Parking: Parking will be available in the vacant lot bounded by 11th Street on the north, 12th Street on the south, Holmes on the west and Charlotte on the east. Shuttle will be on hand for those needing assistance. Disabled parking will be available on 12th Street, south curb by Federal Building.



Inspection Protocol: Commands for those participating in the Honor Guard:

“At close interval, dress right, dress” – All officers (except the last one in each rank) place their left palm on their left hip and extend their left elbow. Each officer adjusts position so the right arm just touches the next officer's left elbow. All officers face to the right (except the first officer in each rank).

“Ready, front” – All officers turn sharply to the position of attention and drop their arms to their sides – feet together, facing front.

"Cover" - Each officer in the second rank adjusts his position to stand exactly behind each officer in the first rank, then the third rank follows. This provides a uniform appearance and compensates for different arm lengths.

"Present arms" - Salute with the right hand

"Order arms" – Drop saluting hand back down

"Parade rest" – All officers remain facing front with their right foot in place. The left foot is moved to the officer's immediate left (12 to 15 inches). The officer's hands are placed in the small of the back with elbows bent. No talking or movement is permitted while at parade rest.
