TITLE: Streetcar Authority-Officer

ELEMENT OF ASSIGNMENT: Central Patrol Division

VACANCY STATUS: Anticipated

EXPIRATION DATE: April 10, 2026

REQUIREMENTS:

For this process, sworn law enforcement members with no change in employment status, holding the rank of Police Officer/Detective with a minimum of three (3) years consecutive service, eighteen (18) months of which must have been served in a line element of the Patrol Bureau. Must have an Academy graduation date on or before **11/22/2022**.

Must be highly motivated and able to perform effectively without the need for close supervision.

Must be willing to accept a minimum one-year assignment.

Must be CIT trained or scheduled to attend the next CIT training course.

Must be willing to work variable hours, during inclement weather, and when necessary, flex hours and work extended tours of duty.

Attend Streetcar board meetings as necessary for security issues and address customer concerns regarding safety, security and quality of life issues.

Physically check Streetcar buildings, train platforms, and may be required to ride various train routes during their tour of duty.

Maintain a good working relationship with the private security team employed by the KC Streetcar Authority.

The hours and duration of assignment will mirror the current Patrol Bureau 11 hour, 4-on 4-off plan along with the “6-hour day” with the two Officers on an A and B shift, with duty hours of 1400 to 0100.

This assignment does include a marked “Take Home” vehicle provided and funded by the KC Streetcar Authority. They do require that the vehicle not be used for any other off-duty employment other than that offered by the KC Streetcar Authority.

Officers will respond to calls for service on all Streetcar facilities and/or trains.

All disciplinary actions received by the applying officer within the previous two-year period involving misconduct will be considered in determining whether an officer can participate in the selection process.

All interested qualified law enforcement members who meet the above requirements must submit a Request for Transfer, Form 4 P.D. through their chain of command. In addition, one copy must be submitted to the Human Resources Division (HRD) as well as one copy with a completed Selection Process Candidate Review Form, Form 417 P.D. (With chain of command endorsements). Also, a resume along with a current demeanor record sent via Email/Inter-department mail directly to **Sergeant Aaron Bryant-Central Patrol Division Downtown Foot Beat Unit** no later than **April 10, 2026**.

Qualified applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview at a later date and time.
