

Tactical Rifle / High Risk Vehicle Stop Training

TRT is offering a 6-hour block of Tactical Rifle and High-risk vehicle stop training to a limited number of Patrol Personnel. **This class is specifically designed for officers who are patrol rifle qualified and have their own patrol rifle.** The first 4 hours of this class will provide officers the opportunity to advance the fundamentals of utilizing a patrol rifle in a close quarters environment.

This training block will provide the following:

4-hour POST training block on the fundamentals of using a Patrol Rifle in a Close Quarters environment and will focus on skills such as:

Weapon presentation and manipulation from both low ready and high ready.

Knowing the off set of your rifle optic.

Conducting reloads and transitions.

Engaging targets from the threshold assessment.

Engaging multiple targets

Recoil mangement

2-hour block that covers updates to high risk stops which includes:

Vehicle positioning

Conducting business from the rear of the vehicle as opposed to doorways

How to properly take subjects into custody

How to move as a team to clear the car safely

Classes have been scheduled for both A and B shift training days and are limited to 12 students at a time. 4 hours of Missouri Post Credit will be provided for attendance.

Dates are May 22 (B SHIFT), June 26 (B SHIFT), July 24 (A Shift), August 14 (A SHIFT)

Training will take place at Coalmine Range from 0900-1500. Ammo is provided courtesy of the range. YOU MUST BE PATROL RIFLE QUALIFIED TO ATTEND.
