

The Missouri Department of Public Safety, Missouri Office of Homeland Security is hosting an (ALERT) Active Attack Incident Management (AAIM) Course in Jefferson City. **This is a 16 hour course with a 30 person maximum.** The training will be held on **March 24th and 25th, 2026**, at the Missouri Department of Public Safety (Lewis & Clark Building), 1101 Riverside Drive, Jefferson City, 65101 - First Floor, LaCharrette Conference Room, and will go from (8:00am to 5:00pm every day). **CLEE training credit will be awarded and there is no cost to attend the course, but attendees are responsible for all travel costs, meals, and lodging.**

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Active Attack Incident Management (AAIM) from ALERT

The Active Attack Incident Management (AAIM) two-day course, is designed for senior level leadership among our first responders. AAIM focuses on strengthening the coordination and integration of multiple response entities to improve overall effectiveness during critical incidents. This course is designed to enhance participants' skills, abilities, and performance in utilizing the NIMS ICS process during active attacks and other major critical incidents. Participants will be challenged through a series of tabletop exercises Powered by AIKI ResponseREPS that reinforce key concepts and require them to apply what they've learned in realistic, scenario-based environments enabling them to improve both individual and agency response capabilities. AAIM works through various operational phases, staging protocols, command elements, terminology, communication, incident command, area command, and EOC operations. Developed with input from subject matter experts and based on NIMS ICS principles and real event research, this course offers a comprehensive platform to boost participants' ability to effectively use the incident command structure in dynamic situations. Sixteen hours of ALERT training are awarded for completion of this course.
